Team & individual entries will be accepted from 9:00am April 19 to Noon June 23, 2019 (late entries cannot be accepted)

WINE SURVIVOR RAFFLE RULES

1. Each individual entrant will pay a fee of \$35.00 cash; \$22.00 of which will be assigned as entry fee and the remaining \$13.00 will be used to purchase, on your behalf, a bottle of wine with a minimum value of \$13.00. We will accept a maximum of 520 individual entries into the raffle. Maximum proceeds are \$18,200.00. (in this raffle \$11,440.00 would be the profit realized for the Facility Renewal Fund with \$6,760 assigned as wine value). Each entrant will be assigned to a 5-member team. Organizers will ensure that the total number of entries is divisible evenly by 5. Any entries that cannot be assigned to a team will be refunded. Individuals may enter more than once and each entry will be treated as a separate entry.
2. Each team will have 1 person assigned as Team Captain. The Team Captain is responsible for notifying other team members when their team has been eliminated and distributing prizes if their team is a winner.
3. Entries will be accepted until Noon on June 20, 2019.
4. As in the TV show Survivor, participants are eliminated until only the winner remains. Elimination draws will start Monday, June 24, 2019 and will be held daily until Friday June 28 until only 10 entries remain. The final 10 will be drawn at Highlands Community Centre Pub night on June 28, 2019. As names are drawn, that person is eliminated, but may still be on a winning team. A team is eliminated when all team members have been eliminated. Approximately 1/5 of the teams will be eliminated each day. Draws will continue until all teams have been eliminated except 1. The final team remaining is the First Place Winner; the second-last team to be eliminated is the Second Place Winner and so on. Prizes are awarded for the final 7 teams, as well as a consolation prize for the first team eliminated.
5. Team Captains will be notified daily via Facebook post and/or email on the draw results on each of the draw dates. The final draws and announcement of winning teams will be made at the regular pub night on June 28, 2019. Team Captains will be notified by phone or email if not in attendance — prizes will be available for pick up by the Team Captains on that date, or at a mutually agreed alternate date and location. It is the responsibility of the Team Captain to arrange for delivery to team members.

7. Prizes are awarded to teams as follows, based on 520 bottles (to be distributed equally to each team member).
 - a. 1st Place — 120 bottles of wine
 - b. 2nd Place — 90 bottles of wine
 - c. 3rd Place — 80 bottles of wine
 - d. 4th Place — 70 bottles of wine
 - e. 5th Place — 60 bottles of wine
 - f. 6th Place — 50 bottles of wine
 - g. 7th Place — 40 bottles of wine
 - h. Consolation to first team eliminated — 10 bottles of wine
8. If the number of entrants and bottles of wine are less than 525, 2nd through 7th place prizes will be prorated based on the number of bottles available for prizes. Consolation prize and 1st Prize will remain at 10 and 120 respectively.
9. Draws will be made at location to be determined. All Draws will be conducted by a minimum of 2 members (1 HCL Board member and 1 member of HFRC member).
10. No person under of the age of 18 years may enter the raffle. Tickets must be purchased in the province of Alberta. The ticket will indicate that a purchaser must not write in the name of a person under age 18.
11. All bottles of wine purchased with entry fees will be distributed as prizes. No cash prizes will be awarded. All cash received as entry fees will be retained by the Highlands Community League assigned to the Highlands Facility Renewal Fund as proceeds of the raffle.
12. Payment of the \$35.00 entry fee will be made in cash. 1 bottle of wine will be purchased as part of each entry fee paid.
13. There are no restrictions on the participation of members, families, volunteers of the Highlands Community League Board or their subcommittee members.
14. If 300 tickets are not sold by June 18, 2019 (10 days prior to draw date), the Highlands Community League Board (HFRC) reserves the right to request a draw extension or cancellation from the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission.
15. Any bottles of wine unclaimed after 3 months from the final draw date will become the property of the Highlands Community League.
16. The Highlands Community League and the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission are not responsible for any disputes which may arise between the different individuals who have chosen to enter the raffle.
